Shanghai Pre-college for International Students

Shanghai Pre-college for International Students (SPIS) is established by Shanghai Education Committee. As the education base for international students at the level of pre-college, it is hosted by Shanghai Normal University (SHNU) who is responsible for its teaching and administration.



Backed by the outstanding teaching faculty, academic achievement and other education resources from SHNU, and learning from the model and experience of pre-college education for undergraduate with Chinese Government Scholarship, SPIS formulates curriculum and administration mechanism suitable to pre-college students. The goal is to prepare students to be qualified for undergraduate study at universities in Shanghai through the acquisition of the Chinese language knowledge, related science knowledge and cross-cultural communication abilities.

Introduction

1. Applicant

SPIS is open to those who plan to get enrolled in undergraduate program in universities in Shanghai, but whose Chinese language proficiency, related science knowledge and cross-cultural communication abilities have not yet reached the requirements for undergraduate study.

2. Courses

The duration is one year.

1st semester: intensive Chinese language courses (30 lessons per week)

2nd semester: intensive Chinese courses (24 lessons per week), Chinese culture (2 lessons per week), comprehensive science (2 lessons per week) and comprehensive art courses (2 lessons per week).

3. Teaching faculty

Based on the advantage of the teaching and academic resources of SHNU, SPIS has established an excellent teaching team. All of them are equipped with solid expertise, rich teaching experience and first-rate overall qualifications.

4. Facilities

All classrooms are equipped with air-conditioners, multi-media facilities. And the language lab is equipped with digital audio facilities. In the teaching building there can be found coffee machine, drinking facilities, lounge and etc. Students are accommodated on campus. - 5. Transcripts for all courses in secondary school (notarized Chinese or English translated copy are required for non-Chinese or non-English documents)
- 6. Rewards certificates proving academic performance or social capabilities (notarized Chinese or English translated copy are required for non-Chinese or non-English documents)
- 7. Personal statement (no less than 800 words, including introduction and study plan)
- 8. Copy of the passport page with passport number.(if the passport has been prolonged, the copy of prolonging page is required)
- 9. Two recommendation letters by teachers from secondary schools (notarized Chinese or English translated copy are required for non-Chinese or non-English documents)
- 10. One passport-size photo (38mm*51mm)


